Dr. Moodie has over two decades of experience conducting audiology-based research and is the recipient of an Ontario Ministry of Research and Innovation Early Researcher Award (ER16-12- 144).

As Principal Investigator in the Family-Centred Early Intervention Laboratory at Western University (www.uwo.ca/nca/fcei) her recent research is focused on developing strategies and tools to support families within early hearing detection and intervention programs, including the development of video-based tools (www.uwo.ca/nca/fcei/hearon).

Dr. Moodie has published over 60 peer- and non-peer-reviewed publications and has delivered more than 100 presentations of her work world-wide.
