

Anisa has a Bachelor Degree in Law and is trained for parental support, advocacy, rehabilitation and inclusion education of the Deaf and HoH population, early detection and intervention, project cycle, etc.

She is an active member and a legal adviser for several non-governmental organizations in Bosnia and Herzegovina, and a valuable contributor to local leadership.

She is one of the initiators and team members of the Project “Universal Neonatal Hearing Screening” (UNHS) the purpose of which is to lay a foundation for UNHS throughout the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina. She is also, the initiator and author of legislation aimed at regulating legal, social, health and educational aspects of the lives of Deaf and HoH people and their families.

She has played a pivotal role in initiating and establishing the cooperation and membership between Bosnian association and European associations: EURO CIU (European Association of Cochlear Implant Users) and Fepeda (European Federation of Parents of Hearing-Impaired Children) and is a representative in their activities.

Anisa is one of the initiators of activities aimed at reaching health, social and educational rights for the Deaf and HoH population (regarding the inclusive education, improving the status of students with disabilities and providing necessary support in the study, etc.) and plays a valuable role in establishing and promoting parent to parent support in Sarajevo Canton and beyond.
