

PD Dr. Daniel Holzinger



PD Dr. Daniel Holzinger is a Clinical Linguist at the Institute of Neurology of Senses and Language at the Hospital of St. John of God in Linz, Austria. He is director of the Centre for Communication and Language that includes multidisciplinary diagnostic services for children with developmental disorders as well as intervention programs for children with hearing loss, speech and language impairment and autism spectrum disorders.

Dr. Holzinger received his MA and PhD in Applied Linguistics from the University of Klagenfurt Austria, and wrote his habilitation thesis at the University of Graz, where he is a senior lecturer.

Dr. Holzinger is deputy director of the Research Institute for Developmental Medicine at the Johannes Kepler University in Linz. He conducts research in the areas of spoken, written and signed language and socio-emotional development of children who are deaf or hard of hearing. Other research interests focus on the early identification of speech and language disorders and the efficacy of intervention approaches in speech-language-communication. Since 2012 Dr. Holzinger organizes the biannual International Congress on Family-Centred Early Intervention for Children who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing as part of the FCEI International Executive Group.
