



Johannes Fellinger, M.D, P.D., is Head of the Institute of Neurology of Language and Senses at the Hospital of St. John of God in Linz and Head of the Research Institute for Developmental Medicine, Johannes Kepler University Linz, Austria.

After finishing his medical degree, he specialised in Neurology, Psychiatry and Neuropaediatrics. During his residency, he noticed a lack of medical services available for Deaf people and started an outpatient clinic for the Deaf. This developed into the Institute of Neurology of Language and Senses.

The multidisciplinary Institute includes also a neurological and linguistic clinic, a paedoaudiological centre with an early intervention program for deaf and hard of hearing children, a centre for autism spectrum disorder for children, adolescents and adults, an outpatient clinic for inclusive medicine and Lebenswelt - therapeutic living communities for Deaf people with multiple disabilities.

Additionally to his clinical work, Johannes Fellinger is involved in research, particularly in the field of developmental medicine, with a focus on Deafness, mental health, Quality of Life and autism spectrum disorder. He teaches developmental medicine and associated fields at the Johannes Kepler University, Linz as well as at the Medical University Vienna at the Institute of Public Health.
